Education Pack

Introduction

This education pack is aimed at **Key Stage 2 students (Y5- Y6)**. It is hoped that the topics covered can give an insight into the **Local History** of **Beeleigh Steam Mill** during the Industrial Revolution of the 18th and 19th centuries using the mill as a case study.

It is suggested that particular subject areas within the pack can contribute towards a better understanding of Mathematics, Science, History and Geography at Key Stage 2 level. With this in mind topics are accessed through combinations of **Puzzles, Games** and where possible, **Practical Tasks**.

It is up to the visiting staff which topics they wish to complete on site and which back at school from the pack as weather and time can be a limiting factor. School to bring writing materials.

A visit to the mill together with talks given by **BMRG** volunteers is free and usually takes between 1- 2 hours. A visiting party is usually split into smaller groups of 5 - 6 to ease movement around the site. it should be noted that at present there are very limited toilet facilities (portaloo!). Visiting staff must remind students to adhere to safety guidelines where pointed out. There are very limited parking facilities on site so it is suggested that drop-off is made at the Beeleigh Falls Parking space on the Maldon Golf Course approach lane.
